RULES OF THIS BED

This bed is for Arguing, Making Love, Sleeping, Reading, and Folding Laundry (in that order).

ONE PERSON CASE

You may argue and make love with yourself. You may sleep, read and fold laundry by yourself.

TWO PERSON CASE

If both people want to do the same thing then do that thing.

Try not to argue in this bed unless you are willing to make love instead.

Otherwise, if one person wants to argue and the other wants to make love then one can argue with him/herself and the other can make love to him/herself.

You may make love in this bed even if you don't want to have an argument.

If you want to sleep, read, or fold laundry and avoid having an argument or making love then sleep elsewhere.

Best case: Arguing and then making love because make-up sex is the best.

Worst case: Making love and then arguing without a good night's rest first.

Laundry doesn't actually need to be folded.

THREE PERSON CASE

Let's get the two person case working smoothly before inviting a third person.

NOTES

Making love and sex are not the same thing.

It is better to start making love and see if it leads to sex than to start with sex and see if it leads to love. (Exception: After an argument go straight to sex before someone falls asleep or another argument breaks out.)

Instead of unsettled arguments preventing sex let's see if uninterrupted sex can prevent arguments.

If one of us never wants to argue or make love again then both of us should get divorce lawyers.

(Exception: If we are not married and we argue all the time and never make love then we might as well get married first and then call the lawyers immediately.)

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
