The editors of *DDJ* shall have the right in their sole and exclusive discretion to edit, rewrite, condense, abridge, or otherwise change the contribution as required, taking care, of course, not to change your meaning.

If the above terms are agreeable to you, please sign all copies and return one. If your company owns the copyright to the manuscript because you prepared it as an employee, an authorized company representative should sign this agreement as well.

Please understand that this letter embodies the entire agreement between yourself and CMP, that your signature indicates acceptance of the terms set forth herein, and that no waiver or modification of the terms herein shall be valid unless made in writing and signed by both of us.
