You are helping to evaluate materials for testing artificial intelligence programs. Please note: This is not an intelligence test or a psychological test. I am not trying to determine how well you do on the test. I am trying to make sure that the meanings of these texts are clear to a human reader.

You will be given a set of questions. Each question consists of

- A short (one, two, or three sentence) text. In each text, there will be a pronoun in boldface.
- A snippet from the text containing the pronoun, just to emphasize which pronoun is at issue.
- A list of possible terms in the text that the pronoun might refer to.

In most cases, one of the terms should be a much more plausible referent than the rest. If so, write the letter of that choice next to the list of choices. If you feel that there are more than one possibility in the list that are more or less equally plausible, write X next to the list of choices. Please do not spend a lot of time carefully pondering probabilities; if the choice is not pretty obvious, mark the question with an X. On the other hand, do not try to come up with far-fetched readings that would have an alternate solution.

## Example:

The trophy did not fit in the suitcase, because **it** was too large.

Snippet: it was too large.

- A. the trophy
- B. the suitcase.

In some cases, the same text will be used with different pronouns for several consecutive questions. In some cases consecutive questions will have texts that are similar but not identical. Both of these cases will be marked, to avoid confusion.

In all cases, please make sure that you are answering about the pronoun in boldface, and not some other pronoun in the text.

If you don't know the meaning of a word, then feel free to ask me.
