1. The Dream of the Universal Language.

Mathematics is the universal language, applicable to all intellectual situations. (Descartes, Leibnitz)

2. The Dream of Indubitability.

The statements of mathematics are absolutely and universally true. (Russell, Hilbert, Gödel)

3. The Dream of Infinity.

Mathematics creates, uses, and discusses infinities of many sorts.

4. The Dream of Oracularity.

Mathematics, as an adjunct to other disciplines such as astronomy, physics, economics, describes the present and predicts the future.
